SAN ANTONIO TOURS:

**Tour #1
FREDERICKSBURG IN A DAY
Tuesday, July 28, 2009
9:00am-5:00pm**



While travelling approximately 60 minutes into the beautiful Texas Hill Country, your professional guide will indicate points of interest along the way and give everyone information about the fascinating history of this beautiful area.

We arrive in Fredericksburg, Texas. This town settled by German immigrants in the early 1800's is rich with heritage. There are numerous historical buildings, restaurants and museums along the main streets. The many shops located along the Main Street are in a four-block area and a delightful place to get unusual things from the Hill Country and from Texas. The Nimitz Museum, full of WWII history, is part of this unique town.

Lunch can be at the Navajo Grill or Friedhelms authentic German Restaurant, based upon availability. After lunch we continue our exploration of Fredericksburg and then board our coach to stop at the Wild Seed Farm. This is one of the nation's largest wildflower farms. You can cut your own bouquet during your self-guided, self-paced tour. There is also the Butterfly Haus where you can walk amongst Texas native butterflies.

Price: \$150.00 per person with a 15 person minimum and no maximum.

Note: \$115.00 per person without lunch, lunch costs will be on your own.

Tour #2
RAFTING ON THE GUADALUPE RIVER
Wednesday, July 29, 2009
9:00am-4:00pm



The river is waiting for everyone to select a tube or raft or canoe and off you go into the average 68+ degree water for a leisurely float down this river where there are curves, bends, rapids and great scenery.

From the hotel, this is a 45 minute drive to the river's edge. Everyone can select their "vehicle" of choice. Guides will assist with the float, especially for those who choose to walk around the rapids. Tubes of beverages can float right along side your group too!

Price: \$85.00 per person with a 20 person minimum and no maximum.

Includes Capers uniformed tour guide, transportation, all river and tube rental fees and refreshments on the bus.

Everyone must wear some sort of water or tennis style shoe and know how to swim.

Tour #3
SPOTLIGHTING THE CITY TOUR
Thursday, July 30, 2009
11:00am-4:00pm



Our first stop will be Mission San Jose. Here we will view a film and then walk the grounds. The famous Rose Window and the cemetery from the 1770's will be points of interest. This represents the Spanish influence in the early years of San Antonio's development.

After our visit to Mission San Jose we will begin our driving tour of downtown San Antonio seeing the Spanish Governor's Palace, San Fernando Cathedral and the Ursuline Academy, home of The Southwest School of Art & Craft which is a working art school with it's beautiful grounds and one of a kind gift shop.

Next we will be back on the bus to travel to The King William Historic District. We will take a short walk down the tree lined streets of yesteryear where many of the homes were built in the 1860's with the influx of German immigrants.

A visit to this district would not be complete without a tour of the Guenther House. The Guenther family built this home in 1876, which has been carefully restored and turned into a frequently visited museum and tea room today with a wonderful gift shop and a great place for breakfast or lunch.

As we head back towards the heart of the city, we will be sure to see the San Fernando Cathedral in all her majesty. This amazing church is the longest continuously active Catholic church in the country and also houses the crypt with the remains of the heroes of The Alamo.

Returning to the hotel, everyone will have great memories and stories to share.

**Tour #4
CAVE WALKING
Saturday, August 1, 2009
9:00am-1:00pm**

For a high energy activity, our motor coach will travel to National Bridge Caverns for a one and one half hour tour of these famous caves, recently voted to be one of the top ten caves of the United States.

Except for the lighting, walkways and handrails, you will find the North Cave much the same as the discoverers did in 1960. There is an incredible world of towering formations, majestic formations created at an average rate of only one cubic inch every one hundred years. As the constant dripping of water proves, they're still alive and growing.

For even more activity and adventure, there will be "panning for gold", Rip Cord and Rock Wall Repelling, also available right there on site.

The Mining Company Sluice gives guests of all ages the opportunity to pan for gems and minerals as miners once did in their search for gold. Rather than dig, guests pour a bag of rough (sand, dirt, gems, minerals) into a screen-bottom box over a trough of flowing water. As gems are discovered, they can be identified at one of the assay stations or by using an identification chart. Don't think only kids will enjoy this either!

The Watchtower Challenge includes a 50 feet tall climbing tower and two 350-foot zip lines, offering guests even more adventure!

Price: \$85.00 per person with a minimum of 15pp, no maximum but large groups will need to be split up and can be doing some of the other activities while another group is in the caves.

Includes Capers uniformed tour guide, transportation, cave entrance fees as well as refreshments on the bus.

Note: Additional fees for rock climbing and zip line are up to each person to pay on site and are not included in the tour price.

Everyone must wear a shoe with good traction and be in reasonably good shape as the caves do have some steep hills.

IDAA GOLF TOURNAMENT
Saturday, August 1, 2009
8:00am-2:00pm

Keith Foster designed this San Antonio masterpiece, which opened in 1993 and has since garnered quite a reputation. A unique course carved out of an abandoned quarry, it placed among the top ten of "America's Top State Golf Courses" in Golf Digest magazine. It offers some of the best views of the city, but don't get caught sightseeing, or this course will eat your lunch. The front nine is pretty open and filled with streams throughout. Upon making the turn, you quickly find out how the course got its name. Nestled within the abandoned quarry, several holes have greens that are bordered on three sides by 100-foot cliffs, with trouble waiting on the other side. In fact, the names given to two of the holes on the quarry side, "Escape from Alcatraz" and "Reload," pretty much tell the story of the back nine.

Price: \$66.00 Per Person

Note: Pricing includes 18 holes of golf, full use of practice range and putting green and cart.

Club rentals are \$55.00 per set and must be known in advance on the registration form. Pro shop purchases and all food and beverage on and off the course are additional charges and up to each person to pay on their own.
